Ohio House Bill 96 (HB 96) mandates that every county, township, municipality, and school district must adopt a formal cybersecurity program. This program must include an incident response plan that outlines who will be contacted first, how to contain a breach, and when to notify the state. The incident response plan must be documented and updated as necessary. If a local government experiences a cybersecurity incident, it must report it to the state, including the Ohio Cyber Reserve. This requirement ensures transparency and accountability in the handling of cybersecurity incidents.
