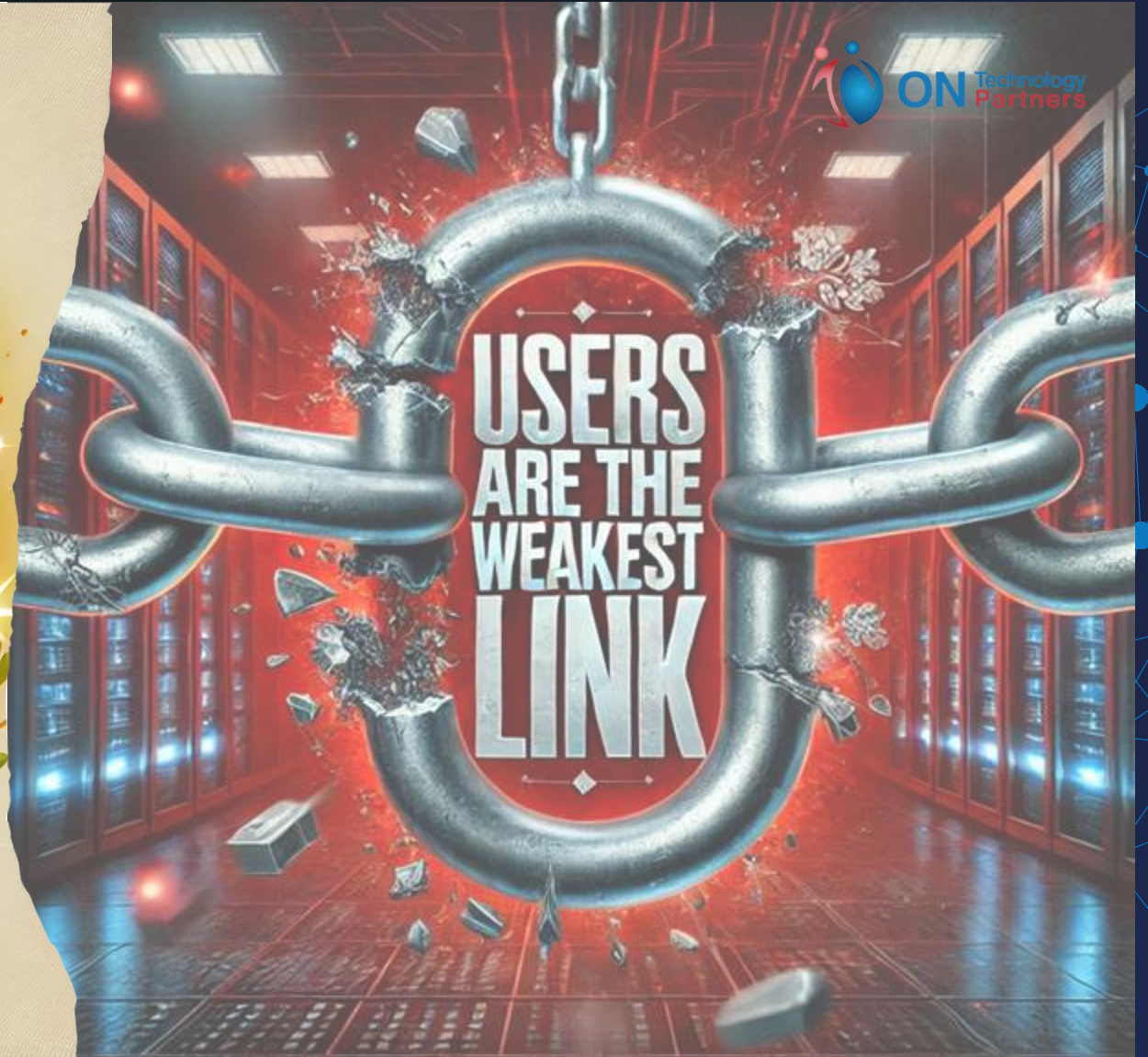

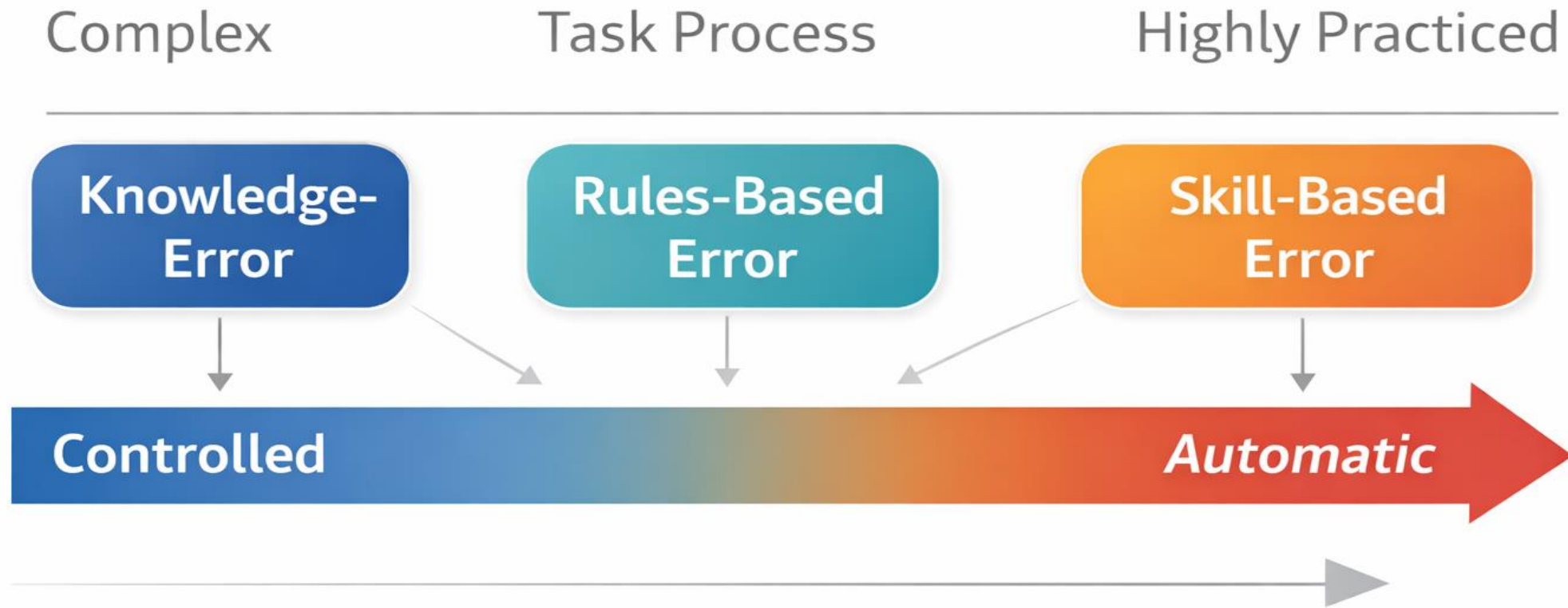

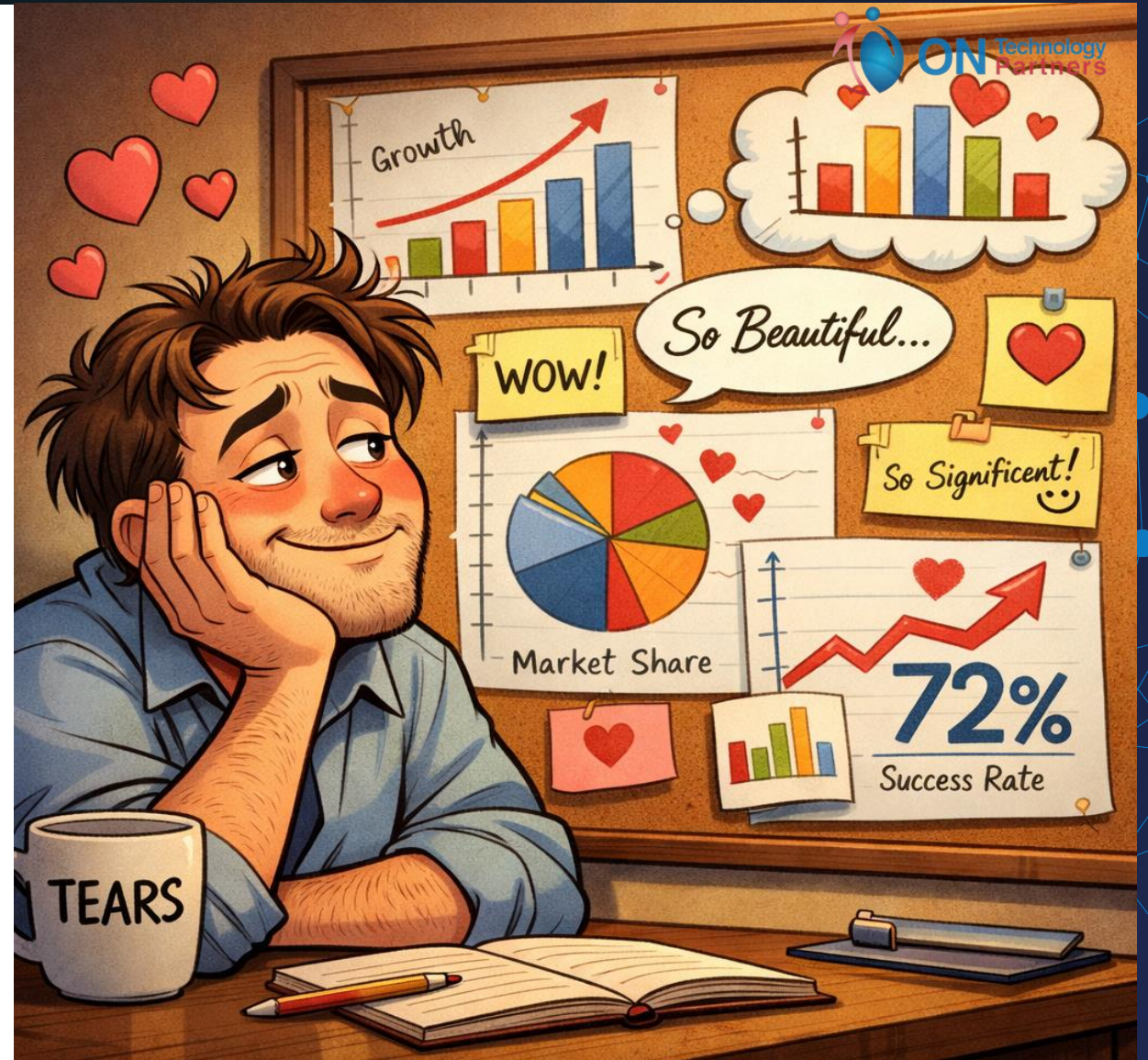

- ❖ The average data breach costs \$4.44 MILLION globally — \$10.22M in the U.S. Secureframe

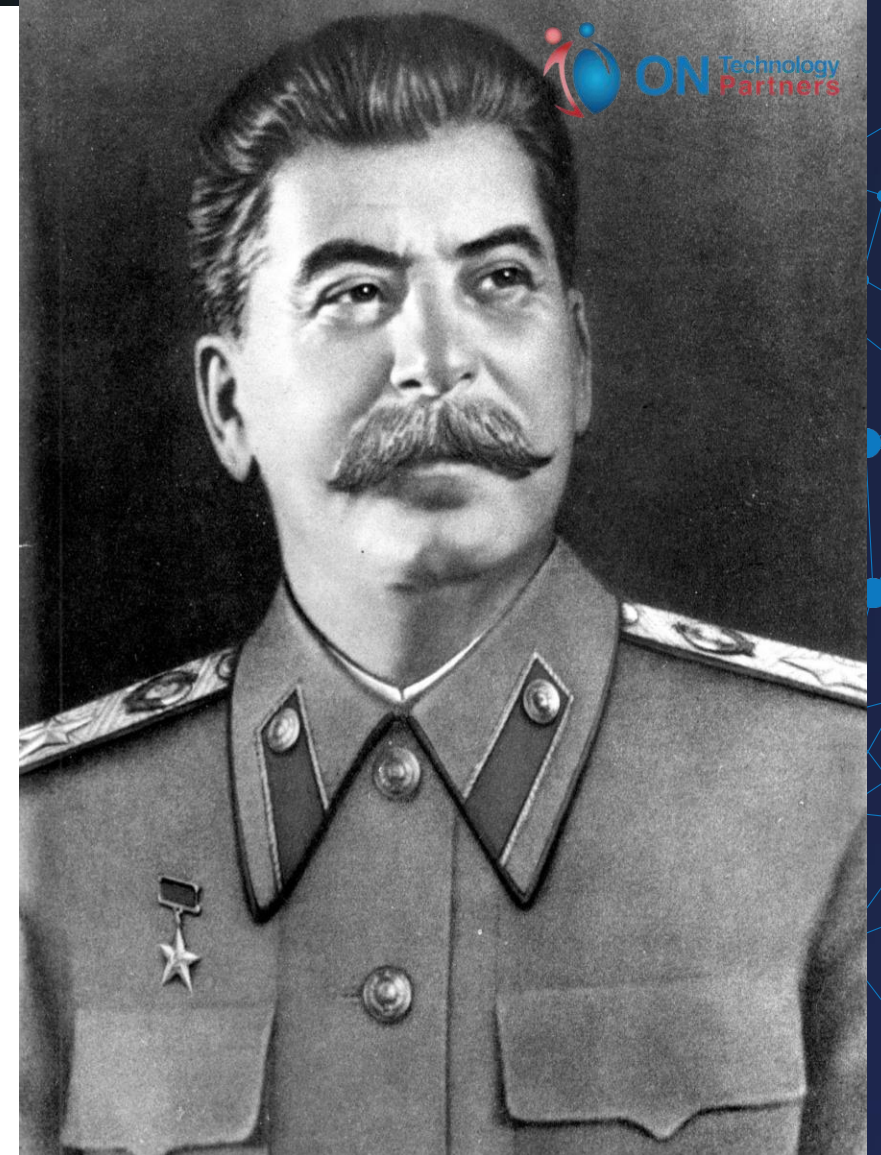

What do you Protect?

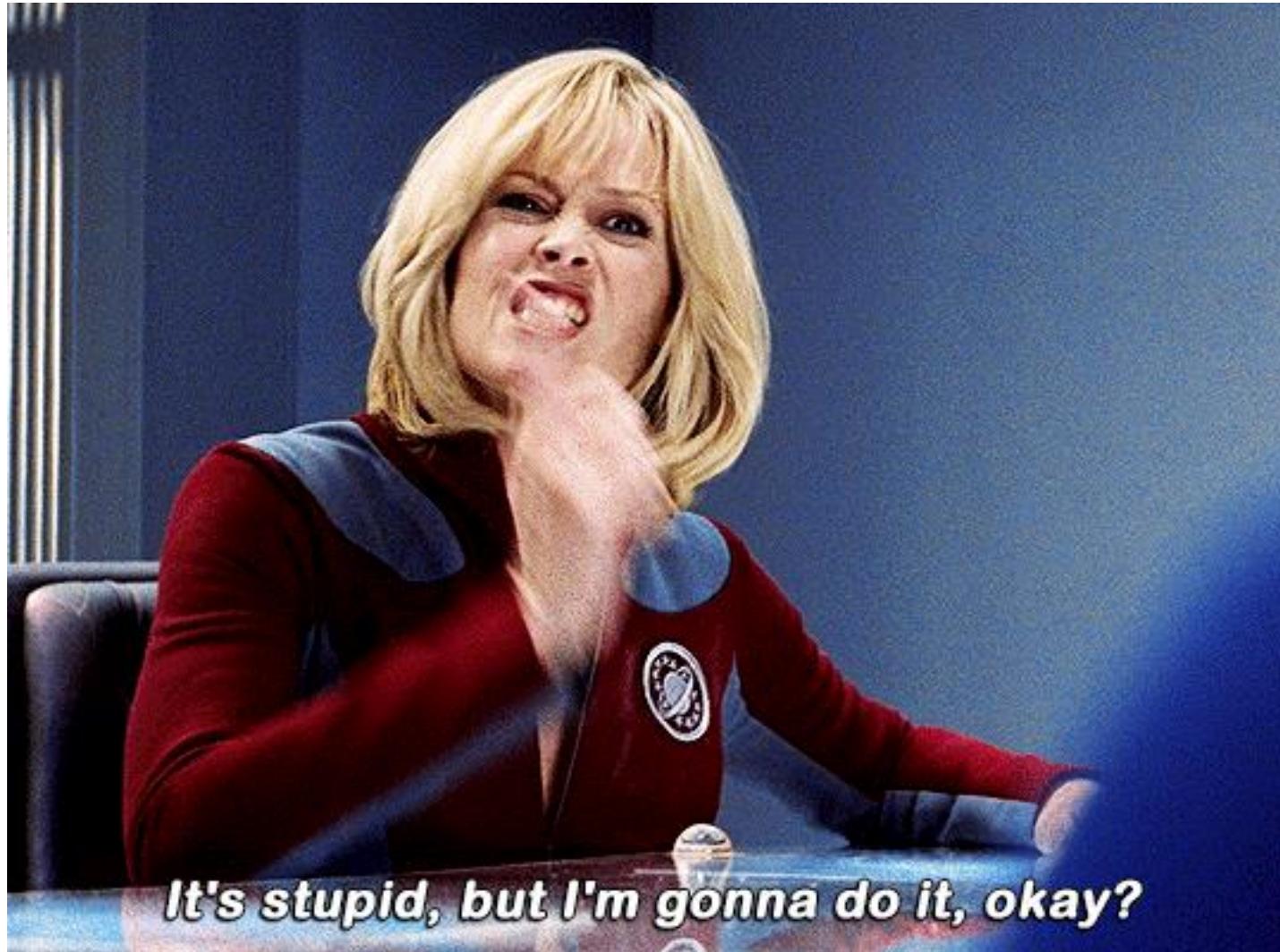
Be honest about security!

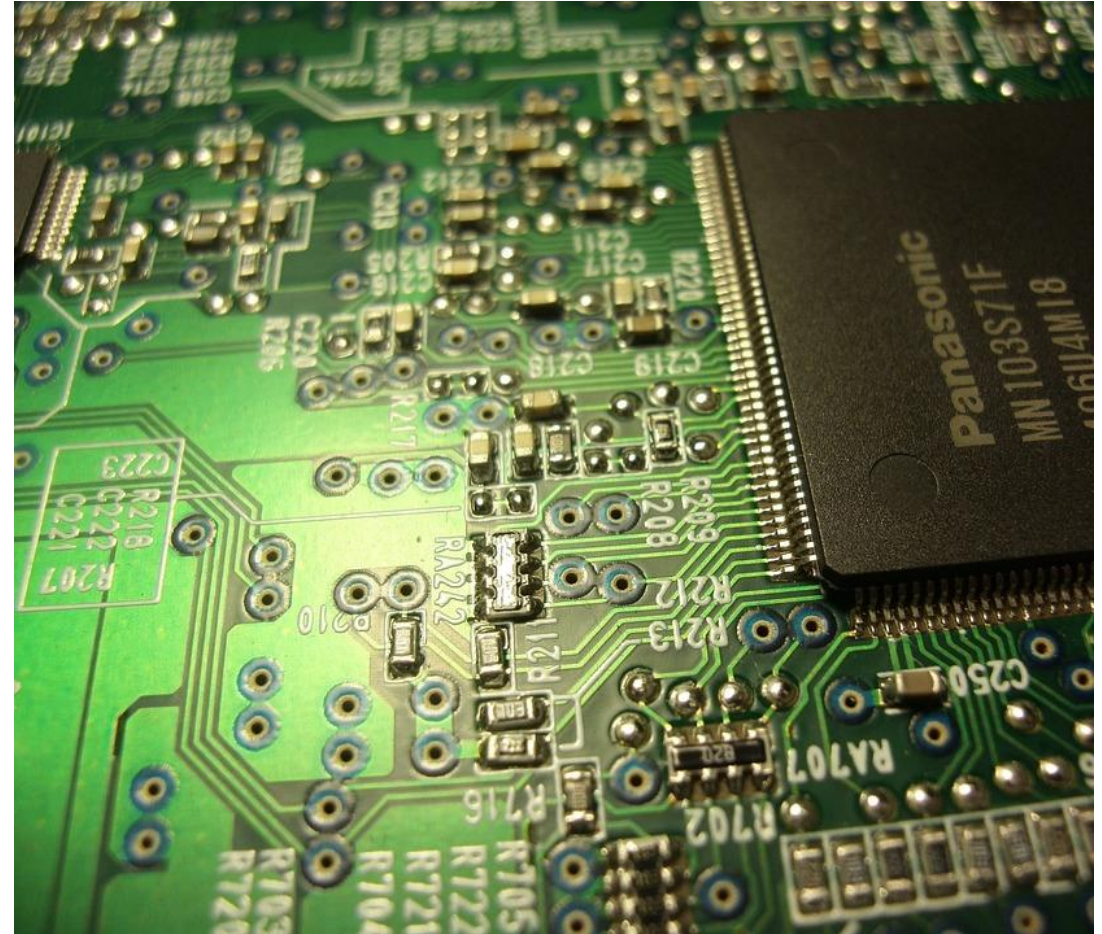
